392	Traffic Plan needed due to volume of traffic and parking problems	Salter's Rd / High St Junction and Hawthorn Road	Parking issues form part of the Gosforth Transport Study , consultation for which has been carried out by Engineering and Design Services . A Working Group with Officers and Councillors has subsequently been set up to discuss findings and cost implications and focus on priorities. The Working Group is currently considering a number of proposals.
395	Trees are causing problems for residents	Moor Crescent, Oaklands, The Drive and Graham Park Road	A Tree Study has been carried out by Consultants. Recommendations from the Study include new tree pits, verge improvements and the narrowing of certain roads. These will all be considered and a plan of works drawn up. The footpaths on Graham Park Road have been scheduled for lifting and relaying in 2008/09. Footpaths on Moor Crescent/Leslie Crescent have also been scheduled to be lifted and relayed. Residents have now been consulted, work is currently underway and is scheduled to be completed by the end of March 2008.
745	Residents would like more recycling facilities	Vicinity of Regent Centre	Consideration is currently being given to siting extra recycling facilities next to the new Customer Service Centre near Regent Centre (former Library).
748	Parking congestion	The Drive	The Neighbourhood Response Manager has discussed options to improve this issue with Engineering and Design Services. Proposals are to be presented to Councillors mid-March 2008.
752	Inconsiderate parking	Junction between Linden Road and Elmfield Road	Engineering and Design Services have drawn up a scheme to deter motorists from parking too close to this junction. Approval is currently being sought.

837	Concern about anti-social behaviour and criminal damage in the vicinity of the play area	Princes Meadow	Council Officers, Councillors and Police are currently working with local residents to address the issue. A number of proposals have been drawn up and will be discussed with the local Resident's Group. These proposals include improvements to the children's play area.
927	Elgy Green	Extra street lighting required	There is potential for funding from either the Sanderson Hospital development or Ward Support/Environmental Ward Stewardship for more street lighting in this area. This is currently being explored further.
