417	Significant amounts of litter and household refuse in streets and back lanes	Northcote Street, Gainsborough Grove, Sidney Grove, Brighton Grove, Chelsea Grove, Tamworth Road, Stanhope Street	<p>Neighbourhood Services has extra dedicated resources to clear certain back lanes on a regular basis. However, this resource is not sustainable and therefore more emphasis will in future be placed on making contact with residents and educating them on how to dispose of their refuse.</p>
			<p>Neighbourhood Wardens and Police Community Support Officers are active in these areas.</p>
			<p>The Neighbourhood Wardens scheme has recently been expanded to cover Arthur's Hill. The Wardens are actively patrolling the area and are now able to issue Fixed Penalty Notices to offenders.</p>
			<p>The Neighbourhood Response Manager is establishing a close working relationship between the Neighbourhood Response Team, Neighbourhood Wardens and the Private Rented Project to help tackle this issue.</p>
			<p>A trial is currently being carried out whereby Wingrove is now covered by the Neighbourhood Response Team 7 days a week. It is intended that the extra weekend working will reduce the build-up of refuse and litter etc which the Neighbourhood Response Team face at the beginning of each week.</p>
