(ADOPTION STATEMENT – REGULATION 19 OF THE TOWN AND COUNTRY  
PLANNING (LOCAL DEVELOPMENT)(ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2004)**

Newcastle City Council adopted the Revised Master Plan and Supplementary Planning Document (“the SPD”) for Newcastle Great Park on 18 May 2006. The SPD provides strategic guidance for future development proposals for the area. The SPD is now a material consideration in the assessment and determination of any Planning Application for this site. In addition and as part of the SPD are the Sustainability Appraisal and Statement of Community Involvement.

The SPD will now be subject to the monitoring process that is required under the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

The Consultation Statement contains the main issues derived from the consultation processes which preceded the adoption of the SPD and how these were addressed in the adopted SPD. A list of consultees is also included in this document.

If you are aggrieved by the SPD, you may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
